State Government in the School Education Department hereby issues a Provisional "No objection Certificate" to the Secondary Wing of Guru Nanak Public School, New Kalora, Andul Road, Howrah - 711 302 for the purpose of preparing its candidates to appear in the final examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education under the following terms and conditions :-

1. The State Government will not bear any financial liability of the school ;
2. The School will not enhance the tuition/other fees without prior express approval of the State Government ;
3. The School will pay its teaching and non-teaching staff emoluments at a rate which should not be less than those of their counterparts with equivalent educational qualifications in the State-aided educational institutions ;
4. The School will provide for Contributory Provident Fund for the employees as prescribed under the relevant Provident Fund Act/Rules of the Govt. of India ;
5. 10% (Ten Percent) of the new admission in the School in each academic year will be allowed on the recommendation of the School Education Department and 50% of such students will have to be allowed to prosecute studies in the school free of any cost ;
6. The School shall have to furnish accurate and up-to-date statistical information relating to the functioning of the school and its academic activities as and when the same is called for by the Deputy Director of School Education (AIS), West Bengal ;
7. Violation of any of the conditions laid down in sub-para (2), (3), (4), (5) and (6) shall entail withdrawal of the 'No objection' of the State Government with effect from the beginning of the academic year next to that in which the violation is committed.


